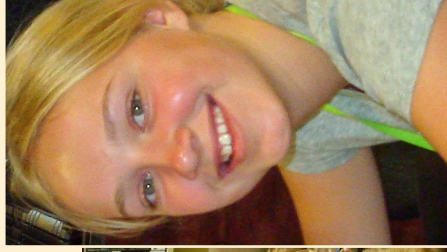

A Foothills Tradition

Thanks to a small cadre of determined volunteers, the Library officially began lending books in Cave Creek on February 14th 1954. Initially, books were circulated from a single shelf at the Cow Bell Restaurant, but residents soon learned that the best bet for getting books was to pick them up at Librarian Dorothy Smith's home—or even better, to just flag her down when they spotted her dusty, little car. Dorothy, a retired librarian from New York, always kept a supply of books in her trunk. She believed in having “*the right book, for the right person, at the right time.*”

From these humble beginnings, the Desert Foothills Library has evolved into a sophisticated and rich resource for the community. While its scope has grown, the Library's purpose remains true: to be at the heart of the community.

You Make It Possible

The Desert Foothills Library is a privately funded, non-profit, free, public library. We are not part of county or city library systems and do not receive any tax-based income. Funding comes from contributions by patrons and other community-minded individuals and organizations who recognize the importance of providing meaningful, educational and social opportunities for life-long learning.

Since our earliest days, volunteers have been the backbone of the Library. Today, more than 80 volunteers support a small paid professional staff to keep the Library open seven days a week. As a team, they provide personal attention in serving the needs and interests of our active community. Additionally, the *Friends of the Library* donates hundreds of hours each week to manage the *Chapter 2 Bookstore* – an important source of revenue for the Library.
